Those who qualify in CBT 2025 shall be issued a **Provisional Eligibility Card (P.E.C.)**, with which they can apply at any DAV school across the country. **Final selection will be made on the basis of DEMO & Panel Interview at Regional level. An application fee of Rs.200/- shall be collected at the Regional Level from the CBT qualified candidates to appear the Phase III interview.**

2.1 MINISTERIAL POSTS:

Assistant (Accounts), Assistant (Admin), UDC (Accounts), UDC (Admin), LDC(Accounts), LDC(Admin), LDC(Receptionist-Ladies only), Library Assistant, Network Assistant, Computer Lab Asst., Nurse(Ladies)

3. ELIGIBILITY:

3.1 EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS (GENERAL):

3.1.1 Regarding Universities/Institutions of outside State, the candidates shall only be eligible for appointment after verification of genuineness of their educational/training qualification from concerned University/Institutions from which they have obtained the degree. Candidates from such outside University/Institutions shall have to produce the authenticated proof of equivalency from any University of the State of Odisha and NCTE recognition in support of their qualification at the time of document verification, failing which they will not be eligible in the selection process.

3.1.2 A candidate furnishing certificates, mark-sheets with grades and grade points shall also furnish numerical equivalency of grades/grade points from the examining bodies.

3.1.3 Candidates must specifically indicate the percentage of marks obtained (calculated to the nearest two decimals) in the relevant columns of the

application. Where percentage of marks is not awarded by the University but only CGPA/OGPASGPA is awarded, the same shall be converted into percentage in terms of conversion norms of University, besides indicating the CGPA/OGPA/SGPA in the application. Candidates will have to produce the certificate/document issued by the University in support of conversion formula of University and percentage of marks, when called for document verification.

3.1.4. The candidates must have qualified CTET/OTET/OSSTET/TET as applicable for the respective posts.

3.2 ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATIONS:

A. POST GRADUATE TEACHERS:

- 1. PGT (Subject Teachers):** Post-Graduate in the advertised subjects[#] with at least 50% marks and B.Ed. degree from any NCTE recognized University.
- 2. PGT (Physical Education):** Master Degree in Physical Education with minimum 50% marks from any NCTE recognized University.
- 3. PGT (Computer Science):** Master Degree in Computer Science/M. Tech / MCA with minimum 50% marks from any recognized University and B.Ed. degree from a NCTE recognized University.

Note:#(i)M.Sc. Degree in Bio-Chemistry from a recognized University after doing a minimum of 6 years study after matriculation (For Chemistry teachers only).Post-Graduation in Pharma-Chemistry or other disciplines related to Chemistry be treated at par with M.Sc. Chemistry provided it is preceded by Graduation in Chemistry.

(ii)Post Graduation in Statistics or Operational research be treated at par with M.A/M.Sc. Mathematics provided it is preceded by Graduation in Mathematics.

(iii) Post Graduation in Micro Biology or Molecular Biology or Agricultural Botany or Genetics or other related disciplines be treated at par with M.Sc. Botany/Zoology provided it is preceded by Graduation in Botany /Zoology.

B. TRAINED GRADUATE TEACHERS:

- 1. TGT(Subject Teachers):** (a) Graduates/Post-Graduates from any recognized University with at least 50% marks in the advertised subjects in either Graduation or Post Graduation and B.Ed. degree from any NCTE recognized University.
(b) Cleared CTET/STET or its equivalent examination (**Paper-II without any condition**).
- 2. TGT(Physical Education):** Graduate/Post Graduate Degree in Physical Education with at least 50% marks from any NCTE recognized University.
- 3. TGT(Computer Science):**(a) Graduate/Post Graduate degree in Computer Science/M.Tech./B. Tech/MCA/BCA with at least 50% marks from any recognized University and B.Ed. degree from any NCTE recognized University
(b) Cleared CTET/STET or its equivalent examination (**Paper-II without any condition**).

C. PRIMARY TEACHERS:

- 1. PRT(Subject Teachers):** Graduates from any recognized University with at least 50% marks in the advertised subjects.
And
DI.Ed./BI.Ed./B.Ed. degree from any NCTE recognized University and cleared CTET/STET or its equivalent examination(**Paper-I without any condition**).

2. **PRT(Physical Education):** Graduate Degree in Physical Education with at least 50% marks from any NCTE recognized University.
3. **PRT(Computer Science):** Graduate degree in Computer Science/B. Tech/BCA from any recognized University with at least 50% marks & B.Ed. degree from any NCTE recognized University and cleared CTET/STET or its equivalent examination (**Paper-I without any condition**).

D. OTHER TEACHING/CONTRACTUAL STAFF:

1. Pre-Primary Teacher (Ladies only):

Graduates from any recognized University with at least 50% marks.

And

Diploma in Nursery Teacher Education/Pre-School Education/Early Childhood Education Programme (D.E.C.Ed.)/DI.Ed. of duration of not less than two years or B.Ed./B.El.Ed. from any NCTE recognized Institute.

Preference will be given to the Graduates having school subjects (Eng., Odia, Hindi, Sans, Math, Physics, Chemistry, Botany, Zoology, History, Geography, Political Science & Economics) with B. Ed. degree.

2. Wellness &Teacher Counselor:

Graduate with Psychology as elective with 50% marks or any graduate with 50% marks having certificate of Diploma in Counseling and experience in counseling in school level. Preference will be given to the Post graduates in Psychology.

3. Music Teacher: Graduate/Post Graduate in/with Music(vocal) from a recognized University with at least 50% marks.

Degrees/Diploma awarded by Prachin Kala Kendra, Chandigarh, Akhila Bharatiya Gandharva Mahavidyalaya and Bangiya Sangeet Parishad shall not be accepted.

4. Art & Craft: Graduate with Drawing and Painting/Art/Fine Art from any recognized University with at least 50% marks and minimum two years full time diploma in Drawing and Painting/Fine Art.

OR

Masters degree in Drawing and Painting/Fine Art from a recognized University.

Degrees/Diploma awarded by Prachin Kala Kendra, Chandigarh, Akhila Bharatiya Gandharva Mahavidyalaya and Bangiya Sangeet Parishad shall not be accepted.

5. Dance Teacher:

Graduate degree in Dance from any recognized University with at least 50% marks.

OR

Graduate in any discipline from a recognized University and Diploma in Dance from recognized institute with at least 50% marks.

Degrees/Diploma awarded by Prachin Kala Kendra, Chandigarh, Akhila Bharatiya Gandharva Mahavidyalaya and Bangiya Sangeet Parishad shall not be accepted.

8. Librarian:

Graduate degree in Library Science with minimum 50% marks from a recognized University (Regular course) with knowledge in Computer application. Preference will be given to the candidates having Post Graduate Degree in Library Science.

N.B. : Good command over spoken English & knowledge of computer application is essential for all the above posts.

E. Ministerial/Non-Teaching staff:

1. **Assistant(Accounts):** Graduation in Commerce from recognized University with knowledge of Typing and Computer, Knowledge **Tally Prime** is essential and minimum ten years' experience in Accounting works.

4. **UDC(Admin):** Graduation in any discipline from recognized University with knowledge of Typing and Computer, Knowledge of noting and drafting is essential and minimum seven years' experience in Establishment works.
5. **LDC(Accounts):** Graduate Degree in Commerce. Proficiency in Computer Application and **Tally Prime** is desirable.

Candidates will submit the Application Form at DAV Zonal/Regional Offices/ Schools on or before November 05, 2024. <i>Candidates can apply for one post/subject only.</i> (only Registered Mobile No. & self email id must be mentioned in the form, so that all further communication from DAVCMC reaches the candidates easily)</p>
<p>3. Application Forms will be scrutinized for eligibility as per CBSE/State Govt./DAVCMC norms for different posts (eligibility mandatory to enter Phase 2)</p>

1. A DAV CBT qualified candidate can apply in any DAV school/zone, whenever and wherever there is a vacancy for the post for which candidate has qualified CBT.
2. DAV Schools/Zones/Regional Offices will conduct demo and interview
3. Those, who clear Phase 3 (demo & interview), will be offered employment in DAV institutions

2. When will the next CBT be conducted?

The next CBT, for session 2024-25 will be conducted in January 2025.

3. Till when is P.E.C. issued for CBT 2024 valid?

P.E.C. 2024 for CBT 2024 issued in March 2024 is :

i) valid till March 2025 only, if the candidate has not been employed by any DAV school after CBT March 2024

ii) valid till March 2025 only, if the candidate joined a DAV school but wants to shift to some other DAV school.

iii) valid EVEN AFTER March 2025, if the candidate has got employment in a DAV school, till the year he/she will keep working in the same school.

4. When and where will Recruitment in DAVs and CBT - January 2025 be advertised?

CBT January 2025 will be advertised from 15 October 2024 onwards all over India in various national and regional newspapers.

10. Who can/will have to appear for CBT 2025?

All those :

- **who have never appeared in any DAV CBT [NEW APPLICANTS as per state wise eligibility criteria]**
- **Who did not qualify CBT 2024 [interested applicants eligible for applied post]**
- **Who qualified CBT 2024, but did not get any job in DAV till March 2025 and P.E.C. going to expire after 31 March 2025 [subject to eligibility]**
- **In-service teachers, who need promotion of designation only [eligibility for higher post required]**
- **CBT qualified candidate, who has got employment at a DAV school by virtue of CBT 2024, need not appear in CBT 2025, ONLY IF he/she continues to work in the same school at the same post.**

- **However, for joining another DAV school, the candidate will have to appear in CBT 2025.**

11. I am a regular teacher working as PRT in a DAV School. Do I need to appear for CBT if there is a vacancy in the same school for TGT? What if there is a vacancy in some other DAV school nearby my location?

With due permission from your school Principal, you will/must appear in CBT 2025 for promotion in designation.

12. A Candidate cleared CBT 2024 and got a 3 year contractual appointment in a school till 2027. Does he/she have to appear in CBT 2025? If not, then Does he/she have to appear in the demo/ interview in phase II?

**No need to appear in CBT 2025 if you are continuing in the same school.
No need to appear in the demo/interview.**

13. Currently, a candidate is staying in Delhi but he/she will move to Odisha in 4 months. From which state should the candidate apply for CBT 2025?

Apply from the state where you want the exam centre. After qualifying CBT, you can apply at any DAV school all over India.

14. If an applicant has cleared CBT for the post of PGT Mathematics, can he/she apply for TGT/PRT Mathematics in some other school?

To apply in some other DAV school, other than where the candidate is presently working, CBT 2025 is required for the desired post.

15. Can I appear for TGT Social Science and PRT English as I am eligible for both the posts?

Candidates can/must apply for 1 post only.

16. Is there any fee for the CBT exam?

Yes, CBT fee will be charged from eligible candidates at the time of CBT Registration from November 21 to December 10, 2024.
